The investigation of your "21" complaint filed against The Sands Regency, which occurred on July 8, 2006, has been completed. The facts and circumstances of the case could not substantiate your claim of \$400.00. My decision, therefore, is that The Sands Regency is not obligated to award you this amount for the following reasons:

You declared the value of the Ace to be a 1 when you chose to double down. You were dealt an Ace and an 8. The posted rules on the game stated double down on 8, 10 or 11. Your total hand value was 9 at the time you doubled down. You were dealt a 2 for a hit card. The posted rules restricted the value of the Ace to a value of 1. Your final hand had a value of 11. The dealer hit out to 17 and won the hand.

If you do not agree with the above decision and wish to appeal it by having a hearing, see the enclosed instruction form.
